A client is suspected of having a peptic ulcer. When obtaining a history from this client, the nurse would expect that reported pain to:

- Intensify when the client vomits
- Occur 1 to 3 hours after meals
- Increase when the client eats fatty foods
- Begin in the epigastrium and radiate across the abdomen

abeel is 28 years old, married, when out with wife to dinner, he became drunk & intoxicated. When left the restaurant, he experienced difficulty in walking & fell. He became verbally abusive with his wife. As she attempt to put him into the car, he became combative. She transported him to E.R. on admission he told the nurse" I'm going home, there is nothing wrong with me". According to this data, what is the appropriate intervention:

- Refer to a nutritionist as needed
- Monitor the client's vital signs, while observing the signs& symptoms of the substance over dose
- Provide client encouragement to initiate appropriate contact with the family
- Support the client to be engaged with support groups

Tissue oxygenation is essential for a child with Sickle Cell Anemia. In order to promote oxygenation you need to carry out which of the following activities (The most important one):

- Keep the child well hydrated
- Avoid low- oxygen environment
- Give small frequent feeding.
